Installation & Aftercare Instructions

IMPORTANT

Wear suitable eye protection when drilling. Take care when using power tools near water - the use of a residual current device (RCD) is advised. Beware of hidden cables or pipes. When drilling tiled surfaces, a piece of masking tape applied to the wall before marking out the fixing holes will stop the drill wandering.

1. Connect the shower head fixing bracket (A) to the wall using the fixings provided ensuring that the bracket is level. Use a spirit level if necessary. Secure also via the mounting tube (B) as shown. Clear the pipe work of dirt and debris before connecting the waterfall and shower inlets.
2. Place the plastic protective cap (C) over the supply holes (D) and apply ceramic tiles to the wall ensuring that the depth of the wall and tiles does not extend past the 'maximum' depth indicated on the plastic cap. This ensures the fixing bracket can support the weight of the shower system safely.
3. Removing the plastic cap, unscrew the metal plugs in the supply holes using the hex key provided. (Figure 4.)
4. Screw the reinforced bars into the shower outlets until tight. Slide the shower head body onto the bars, pushing flush against the wall before fixing it in place with the grub screws on the top of the shower head.
5. Test the water flow through the shower and waterfall outlets and check for any leaks.

Aftercare Instructions

Whilst all these items have a high quality durable finish, they should nevertheless be treated with care. Surfaces should be cleaned using only a soft damp cloth and clean water then dried using a soft cotton cloth. Bath cleaning products, even non-scratch ones, could damage the finished surface.
